By letter dated October 22, 1991 the Department of the Navy released 110 pages of documents pertaining to the above request. Withheld was the name(s) of the individual(s) who made the second request on August 7, 1990 for this same information.

I am requesting a limited release of information based on the following:

The JFK Assassination Information Center of Dallas, Tx. Held a press conference on August 6, 1990.

At that press conference they stated Roscoe Anthony White shot and killed President John F. Kennedy on November 22, 1963.

The participants in the press conference representing the JFK Center were Bud Fensterwald, J. Gary Shaw, Larry Ray Harris, Larry Howard, Joe West, Rev. Jack Shaw and Ricky Don White.

It is possible that one of these individuals requested documentation after the press conference rather than before. I am only interested in determining if one of the above individuals made the request. I am not requesting the name. Only if that name appears on the list submitted.

If that is the case, the JFK Center and its representatives have done a disservice to the family of Roscoe White.
